Our team will work this week (*March 30–April 3*) to update distance learning plans for our students. The plan will be released on April 3rd. The plan will denote how learning will continue for the district's students while schools remain closed through April 24th. Parents and students are encouraged to begin familiarizing themselves with the plan over spring break, April 6th–10th. Distance learning will officially begin for BC students after Spring Break on April 13th .

Students will have 2 weeks to complete the work (4/13/20 - 4/24/20) and work will be due when students return back to school on Monday (4/27/20--tentative).
